A regular meeting of the **BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS** was held this evening, President Art Haywood presiding. Members present were Commissioners Hampton, McKeown, Norris, Portner, Sharkey, and Simon.

Staff present were Charlyn Battle, Director of Human Resources; Michael Fleming, Public Works Coordinator; John O. Hoover, Jr., Director of Parks and Recreation; Mark McDonnell, Public Works Superintendent; Amy Montgomery, Interim Township Engineer; John J. Norris, Chief of Police; Bruce Rangnow, Acting Director of Fiscal Affairs; and Bryan T. Havir, Township Manager. Also present was and Mark Hosterman, Esq., Wisler Pearlstine, LLP. A Public Attendance List is attached.

1. The meeting commenced at 7:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance being led by Commissioner Hampton.
2. Mr. Haywood announced that the Commissioners held an Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss real estate and litigation matters.
3. Each member having received a copy of the Commissioners' Regular Meeting Minutes dated December 19, 2012, Special Board of Commissioners Meeting Minutes dated December 27, 2012, and Organization Meeting Minutes dated January 7, 2013, upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Minutes were unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners.
4. Each member having received a copy of the Executive Summary Financial Report of the Manager/Secretary for the month of December, 2012, upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Report was unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners.
5. Each member having received a copy of the Accounts Paid Report for the month of December, 2012, upon motion of Mr. Portner, the Report was unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners.
6. Mr. Sharkey presented a Community Service Award to Kathryn Saltzman for her efforts in raising funds for a canine vest for the Police Department's Canine Unit.
7. Mr. Sharkey presented a Community Service Award to ForceOne for the company's help in providing a canine vest for the Police Department's Canine Unit.
8. Mr. McKeown presented a **Resolution No. 4-13** to William Obrecht, Sr. in recognition of this 50-years of service to the Elkins Park Fire Company (see attached).
9. Mr. Portner presented **Posthumous Resolution No. 5-13** to Regina Banks honoring her late husband Stephen for his years of service to the Wyncote Board of Historical and Architectural Review and the Historical Commission (see attached).
10. Mr. Portner presented **Resolution 6-13** to members of the Cheltenham Emergency Medical Service commemorating that organization's 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

11. Review of the Public Works Committee Meeting Minutes dated January 16, 2013.

a. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved a Certificate of Appropriateness for Application No. L934 to Cedric Johnson, owner of 1444 Willow Avenue, La Mott, for replacing first floor windows.

b. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved a Certificate of Appropriateness for Application No. L935 to My Dung Nguyen, owner of 1514 Willow Avenue, La Mott, for the removal and restoration of the existing front porch.

c. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved a Certificate of Appropriateness for Application No. L936 to More Shopping Center, L.P., owner of 1333 Cheltenham Avenue, La Mott, for exterior alterations to the building's south side façade for a new store front elevator; wall sign on the east side; exterior alterations to the façade along the access drive including a new store front elevator and a sign on the east side rear of the building.

d. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, the Board of Commissioners unanimously agreed to table action on a draft Resolution appointing a Township Treasurer and affixing the compensation.

e. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, and unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners, the Public Works Committee Regular Meeting Minutes dated January 16, 2013, were accepted.

12. Review of the Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes dated January 9, 2013.

a. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, and unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners, the Public Safety Committee Regular Meeting Minutes dated January 9, 2013, were accepted.

13. Review of the Public Affairs Committee Meeting Minutes dated January 9, 2013.

a. Upon motion of Ms. Hampton, the Board of Commissioners unanimously agreed to schedule a Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 20, 2013 to hear any and all comments from the public regarding an application by the CreekSide Co-op for a Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board E-License.

b. Upon motion of Ms. Hampton, the Board of Commissioners unanimously adopted **Resolution No. 7-13** honoring the 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Primex Garden Center. Said Resolution to be presented in March, 2013.

c. Mr. Haywood asked that the Minutes be amended on Page 5, regarding his comment that he wanted the Township's draft Sustainability Plan to be "*implemented*" as quickly as possible. Mr. Haywood stated that he wanted said Plan to be "*adopted*" as quickly as possible.

d. Upon motion of Ms. Hampton, the Board of Commissioners unanimously adopted **Posthumous Resolution No. 8-13** honoring the late Peter Stern for his contributions to the community. Said Resolution will be presented to his family at a future meeting of the Commissioners.

e. Upon motion of Mr. Sharkey, and unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners, the Public Affairs Committee Regular Meeting Minutes dated January 9, 2013, were accepted as amended.

14. Review of the Building and Zoning Committee Meeting Minutes dated January 9, 2013.

a. Regarding the review of the plans and discussion about the proposed new Wyncote Elementary School that took place at above-referenced meeting, Mr. Portner noted that over the past eight (8) years, no child was ever involved in accidents or conflicts from vehicles driven by parents dropping off students. He felt there was erroneous judgment made by individuals who did not want a student drop-off on Barker Road. His children attended the school and in his opinion, the school has a good safety record.

Upon motion of Mr. Simon, and unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners, the Building and Zoning Committee Regular Meeting Minutes dated January 9, 2013, were accepted.

15. Under New Business:

a. In accordance with the Code of the Township of Cheltenham and Article XIII, Section 1302, of the Home Rule Charter, the President of the Board presented reorganizations of the citizens' committees for the advice and consent of the Board.

Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the reorganizations as submitted by the Board President (see attached).

b. Mr. Haywood announced that the following Commissioners were appointed to committees:

1. Commissioners Sharkey and Portner to the Fire Board
2. Commissioner Portner as Chair of the School District/Township Liaison Committee
3. Commissioner Hampton to the Human Relations Committee

c. The award of a Professional Services Contract for Code Enforcement services was considered. Mr. Havar reported that five (5) firms were solicited for proposals, and two (2) firms responded. The proposals were opened on January 18, 2013. Mr. Havar stated that after reviewing both proposals, it is the recommendation of Staff to award a contract to Code Inspections, Inc.

Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, the Board of Commissioners unanimously awarded a Professional Services Contract to Code Inspections, Inc., 605 Horsham Road, Horsham, PA 19044, in the amount of \$63,450, as recommended by Staff, and being within budgetary limitations. Said contract will commence on February 4, 2013, and end on December 31, 2013.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. Portner, and unanimously approved by the Board of Commissioners, the meeting was adjourned.

*Whereas,* In August 1982, the Board of Commissioners passed an Ordinance establishing **EMS** to assist the Police Department in emergency medical situations. In 1983, EMS began weekend operations using a shared Police Department vehicle featuring a first aid kit, a walkie-talkie plugged into the cigarette lighter and a magnetic "ambulance" sign. With an annual budget of just \$3,700, the all-volunteer **EMS** handled 254 calls during its first year; and

*Whereas,* By contrast, **EMS** is a now 24/7, advanced life-support service staffed by 14 career paramedics along with over 20 part-time personnel and a dedicated group of volunteers. Four ambulances are stocked with life-saving devices, including EKGs, defibrillators, advanced oxygen-delivery systems and mobile data computers. An **EMS** motorcycle and three bicycles help **EMS** navigate through crowds and special events. Today, **EMS** averages over 3,000 calls annually.
