A meeting of the PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE was held tonight. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Charles McKeown. Members present were Commissioners Muldawer, Portner, Sharkey, Simon and Swavola. Also present was Ex-Officio member Greenwald. Staff present were Messrs. Bryan Havar, John Hoover, Brian Hinson, Anthony Birdsong, David Kraynik, Ms. Susan Fries and Whitney Campoli. A Public Attendance List is attached.

1. There was a review of the summer programs being offered this year. Mr. Hoover stated that his staff is in the process of draining, cleaning and painting the pools this week. Mail- in registrations have been processed for the last three weeks and walk-in registrations were started last week. Mr. Hinson reported that he will be coordinating and overseeing the playgrounds and summer camp programs. There will be a fitness boot camp for adults, pony share and the annual Flick 'N Float at the pools. Kayaking classes will be offered this summer with six students in each class. A youth golf program will be coordinated with the golf pro at the Melrose Country Club.

Mr. Birdsong reported that Tae Kwon Do, body shaping, concerts in the park and teen camp are some of the programs that will be offered at LaMott Community Center this summer. He stated that we will be bringing back the summer tennis program at Wall, Thomas Williams, and Griffin Parks. A new spring tennis program will be offered starting next Monday evening. Ms. Fries reported that she will be working with the summer playground program again this year. The 52<sup>nd</sup> annual Fishing Derby will be on June 6<sup>th</sup> 2009. Volunteers are needed for the dunk tank for the upcoming playground



carnival on July 28<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Fries also mentioned the family bingo and ice cream social and the Liberty Swim League meets at Conklin and Glenside Pools.


