A meeting of the PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE was held tonight. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Charles McKeown. Members present were Commissioners Sharkey, Simon, Muldower, and Swavola. Staff present were Messrs. David Kraynik, Bryan Havir, John Hoover, Brian Hinson, Anthony Birdsong, and Ms. Susan Fries. A Public Attendance List is attached.

1. Mr. Kraynik gave a brief introduction of an overview regarding adding concession stands to the Township pools.

There was an open discussion regarding the proposal to build snack stands at each of the pools. The concern among the Commissioners was the cost far exceeded the potential revenue. The Committee agreed to look at the proposal at a later date.

2. Mr. Hoover called upon Mr. Brian Hinson, Mr. Anthony Birdsong and Ms. Sue Fries to review upcoming fall programs.

- a) Mr. Hinson spoke to the upcoming Annual Community Harvest Festival on Oct. 10th, and the re- opening of the pool at CHS for swim lessons.
- b) Mr. Birdsong spoke to the programs that will be available at the LaMott Community Center. They will be offering their regular classes, which are Tae Kwon Do, Dance, Body Shaping, and Combo Workout. The new classes that will be offered are sewing, cake decorating and theater. There will be a Halloween Party at LCC on Oct. 31st.
- c) Ms. Fries spoke to the programs that will be available at the Rowland Community Center. There will be a two-day driving course offered for 55 and older drivers. Those that take the class will receive a 5% discount on their auto insurance. Also mentioned was the upcoming Hayride and Bonfire on November 6th.

3. Commissioner Swavola inquired about the kayaking and chess programs. The kayaking class did not run due to lack of interest. The kids chess program ran for a trial bases during the summer and averaged seven participants.

4. Upon motion of Mr. Muldawer, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Recreation Reports for the month of August 2009 were accepted.

5. Upon motion of Mr. McKeown, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Curtis Hall and Glenside Hall Reports for the month of August 2009 were accepted.

6. Upon the motion of Mr. McKeown, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the Building Maintenance Specialist Report for the month of August 2009 was accepted.

There being no further business, upon motion of Mr. McKeown, and unanimously approved by the Committee, the meeting was adjourned.
