OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE
MONTGOMERY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION TO
SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF
CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP AND JENKINTOWN
BOROUGH UNDER THE DELAWARE VALLEY
REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION'S SAFE ROUTES
TO TRANSIT PROGRAM FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
FROM DVRPC PLANNERS TO HELP PLAN AND DESIGN
PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS
AROUND THE JENKINTOWN-WYNCOTE TRAIN
STATION AT NO COST**

WHEREAS, Safe Routes to Transit is a technical assistance program designed by the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (“DVRPC”) to help municipalities and counties bridge the gap between concept development and implementation; and

WHEREAS, the program seeks to match motivated local governments with DVRPC’s subject matter experts to define access issues, refine conceptual improvements, provide cost estimates, identify potential funding sources, and develop implementation strategies; and

WHEREAS, the goal of this collaboration is to provide a project sponsor with the analysis necessary to prepare a compelling application for competitive funding sources that can help advance a project through final design and construction; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township, through the Montgomery County Planning Commission, desires to work with Jenkintown Borough to submit a request to DVRPC for technical assistance to plan and design pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements around the Jenkintown-Wyncote Train Station; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not require matching funds from Cheltenham Township; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizes the Montgomery County Planning Commission to submit a grant application on behalf of Cheltenham Township and Jenkintown Borough under DVRPC’s Safe Routes to Transit Program for technical assistance from DVRPC planners to help plan and design pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements around the Jenkintown-Wyncote Train Station at no cost; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizes the Cheltenham Township Manager to execute any and all agreements, contracts, documents, applications, etc. relating to the grant application or, if successful, administration of the grant, on behalf of Cheltenham Township.
