**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT
APPLICATION UNDER MONTGOMERY COUNTY'S FY 2019
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
FOR THE PURPOSE OF MILLING, PAVING, AND ASSOCIATED
IMPROVEMENTS ON LUCRETIA MOTT WAY IN LA MOTT**

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Department of Housing Services has been allocated monies by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for its Fiscal Year 2019 Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Cheltenham has executed a Cooperation Agreement with Montgomery County for conducting Community Development activities and is a participant in the Montgomery County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Cheltenham Board of Commissioners held public meetings on March 13, 2019 and March 20, 2019, to review the Community Development Block Grant Program proposal with the public and gave the Township citizenry an opportunity to review and comment on proposals as it relates to the CDBG program rules, regulations, and eligible activities promulgated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Community Development Block Grant Program (24 CFR Part 570); and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that in order to be eligible for program participation, the use of funds may be for the construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation or installation of public facilities and improvements, including but not limited to streets, curbs, sidewalks, streetscape improvements, community centers, storm drainage and sanitary sewers which directly benefits those persons which reside in a particular pre-determined low and moderate income neighborhood, as well as primarily benefiting all residents of the Township, which is one of the criteria for satisfying the national objectives of the Department of HUD under the CDBG Program; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township Staff has recommended to the Cheltenham Township Board of Commissioners that a project involving milling, paving, replacing handicap ramps and other associated improvements along Lucretia Mott submitted for funding under the Township's application as part of the FY 2019 Montgomery County CDBG Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham, Montgomery County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the Township Administration be authorized to submit to the Montgomery County Department of

Housing and Community Development, a CDBG funding application for FY 2019 in the amount of \$185,000.00 to mill and pave the roadway, replace handicap ramps, and other associated improvements on Lucretia Mott Way in La Mott:

1) Mobilization/Demobilization	\$ 5,000.00
2) Maintenance and Protection of Traffic	\$ 5,000.00
3) Handicap ramp replacements	\$40,000.00
4) Milling	\$15,000.00
5) Pavement Base Repair	\$45,000.00
6) Paving	\$50,000.00
7) <u>Pavement Markings, including crosswalk</u>	<u>\$25,000.00</u>
	TOTAL Grant Request \$185,000.00
8) <u>Design, Bid, Inspection, Administration (Township Match)</u>	<u>\$25,000.00</u>
	TOTAL Project Cost \$210,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township hereby authorizes the Township Manager to execute all requests, applications, agreements and contracts required by and with Montgomery County to participate in the Program.
