

**Resolution No. 62-19**  
**of the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township**

*Whereas,* THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, with great admiration and respect, honors **CARRIE TURNER** on the occasion of her retirement as of December 31, 2019 after more than 20 years of dedicated service as the President/CEO of Cheltenham Township Library System.

*Whereas,* In July of 1999 **CARRIE TURNER** became the President of Cheltenham Township Library System which includes the Elkins Park and Glenside branches as well as the branches located in the La Mott and Rowland community centers.

*Whereas,* **CARRIE TURNER** was a staunch advocate for libraries, and held leadership positions in both the statewide professional organization (PALA) and the regional organization (SEPLA). She cultivated partnerships with Arcadia University, Older Adult Subcommittee, School District Librarians' Group, Adult School and the School District Strategic Steering Committee. **CARRIE TURNER** followed grant opportunities and secured funding for facility needs and library services; including a Keystone grant for public restroom renovations, funding from LSTA for a digital media lab, and a PDE, grant for group study cubicles, in addition to numerous grants over the years. She stayed informed on technology and trends in order to incorporate new technology and media into the Library System including the launch of the Library System's collection of e-books, digital audiobooks, Playaways and streaming collection. **CARRIE TURNER's** dedication and leadership will be sorely missed upon her retirement at the end of this year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, duly convened in regular session this Eighteenth Day of December A.D., 2019, does hereby officially honor **CARRIE TURNER's** notable career and contribution to Cheltenham Township and the Library System, and her good luck in all her future ventures. It is further directed that this Resolution be spread in full upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy thereof be presented to **CARRIE TURNER**.
