

**Resolution No. 63-19**  
**of the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township**

*Whereas,* THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, with immense appreciation and respect, honors **DREW SHARKEY**, a lifelong Cheltenham Township resident of Glenside, for his 12 years of outstanding service as a Commissioner of Cheltenham Township; and


*Whereas,* **DREW SHARKEY** was sworn in as the Commissioner representing Ward 1 on January 8, 2008, and has served as chair of the Public Works Committee, in addition to chairing the Public Affairs and Public Safety committees. **DREW SHARKEY** was elected by his peer commissioners in Montgomery County to serve as the president of the Montgomery County Association of Township Commissioners in 2013, after serving as vice president for four years. In 2015, the Montgomery County and Delaware County township commissioners elected him president of the Eastern Association of Township Commissioners. This culminated in 2015 with Mr. Sharkey's election as president of Pennsylvania State Association of Township Commissioners. These organizations set legislative goals, advocate for them in Harrisburg and run training events for municipal officials. In 2016, Governor Tom Wolf awarded Commissioner Sharkey the Governor's Award for Excellence in Local Government. In 2017, Governor Wolf appointed **DREW SHARKEY** to the Governor's Commission on Local Government; and

*Whereas,* Prior to serving as commissioner, **DREW SHARKEY** was a member of the Cheltenham Economic Development Task Force, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Committee, and worked on the Township Main Street program, chairing the Organization and Development Committee. He worked tirelessly with Downtown Glenside and neighbors to run the Glenside Arts Festival, Winter Fest and the Food Truck Festival. His dedication and enthusiasm to his community makes him a favorite resident and community advocate. He also serves on the Glenside Fire Company Board, the Custis Woods-Twickenham Civic Association and the Downtown Glenside Community Partnership boards, and the Penn State Alumni Admissions Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, duly convened in regular session this Eighteenth Day of December, A.D., 2019, does hereby officially honor and thank **DREW SHARKEY**, for his 12 years of faithful service as a Commissioner in Cheltenham Township and extends its best wishes for his success in all of his future endeavors. It is further directed that this Resolution be spread in full upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy thereof be conveyed to Commissioner Sharkey.
