RESOLUTION NO. 18- 21

**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF NON-
ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING METER VIOLATIONS,
WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, IN THE TOWNSHIP
UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2021**

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township has not enforced parking meter violations during the COVID-19 health emergency for several reasons, including encouraging residents to patronize Township businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to extend the non-enforcement of parking meters within the Township, with certain enumerated exceptions, until December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that that the Board of Commissioners extends the non-enforcement of parking meter violations throughout the Township until December 31, 2021 with the exception of the following:

1. enforcement of handicapped parking violations;
2. enforcement of fire lane violations;
3. enforcement of overnight parking violations;
4. the parking of any fleet vehicle by a commercial owner, operator, agent or employee;
5. the designated "15 Minute Parking" space in proximity to 21 East Glenside Avenue.


