**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT
APPLICATION FOR THE 2022 ROUND OF THE COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM TO UPGRADE THE CROSSWALKS
AND ADA RAMPS AT FOUR INTERSECTIONS ON EASTON ROAD IN
GLENDSIDE**

WHEREAS, Montgomery County has established the County Transportation Program as a competitive funding program to assist municipalities with improving transportation infrastructure throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County is accepting grant applications to fund transportation projects that meet the eligibility requirements for County Fee for Local Use funds, including construction and repair of public roads and bridges, acquisition and maintenance of traffic signs and signals, lane and crosswalk painting and marking, and curb ramps; and

WHEREAS, the crosswalks on Easton Road in Glenside, particularly at its intersection with Limekiln Pike, Royal Avenue, Springhouse Lane and Glenside Avenue, are worn and no longer serve as a visual guide for pedestrians and motorists of pedestrian crossing locations; and

WHEREAS, crosswalks aid in pedestrian safety by designating a safe space for pedestrians to cross roadways, ensure pedestrian behavior is predictable for motorists, and provide a visual notification to motorists that the space is designated for pedestrians to cross a road at the appropriate time; and

WHEREAS, ADA ramps at these intersections do not meet current standards and must be upgraded; and

WHEREAS, the Easton Road corridor is a dense, mixed-use community where residents and patrons of businesses walk between homes, businesses, transportation centers, and civic and recreation uses, safe and functional pedestrian amenities such as ADA ramps and crosswalks are vital to the Glenside community; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township wishes to obtain \$398,450 from the 2022 County Transportation Program to match the local funding commitment for the Upgrade of the Crosswalks and ADA Ramps at Four Intersections on Easton Road in Glenside.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, desires to file a Montgomery County Transportation Grant application to secure funds in an amount up to \$398,450 for the purpose of Upgrading the Crosswalks and ADA Ramps at Four Intersections on Easton Road in Glenside.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania is committed to completing this project and agrees to provide the required match for this project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County does hereby authorize the Township Manager/Secretary and his/her designee to execute all documents, contracts, and agreements between Cheltenham Township and Montgomery County to facilitate and assist in obtaining and administering the requested grant.
