

The special meeting of the **BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS** for July 2022 was held this evening via web-conference, President Daniel B. Norris presiding. Members present were Commissioners Brockington, Pransky, Areman, and Zygmund-Felt.

Staff present were Robert Zienkowski, Township Manager; Alyson Elliott, Assistant Township Manager; Robert Coyle, Interim Public Works Superintendent; Henry Sekawungu, Director of Planning and Zoning; Edward Joseph Stuckert, Street Lighting & Traffic Signal Superintendent; John Piepsny, Director of Parks and Recreation; Scott Lynch, Fire Marshal; Kenneth Hellendall, Director of Emergency Medical Services/Emergency Management Coordinator, John Slavin, Interim Chief of Police; Heather Samuels, Director of Human Resources; Allen Brown, Property Maintenance Supervisor; and James Slade, Fleet Superintendent. 1. The meeting was commenced by Mr. Norris at 7:40 p.m.
2. Mr. Zygmund-Felt led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Sunshine Act Announcement – Mr. Diasio announced that the Board of Commissioners met in an Executive Session prior to tonight’s meeting to discuss several matters of litigation and personnel items.
4. The Secretary’s Roll Call was answered by Commissioners Areman, Brockington, Norris, Pransky, and Zygmund-Felt. Commissioners Rappoport and Holland were absent.
5. Public Comment on Agenda Items – None.
6. Consideration of the Teamsters Union Local No. 115 Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) for January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2026.

Mr. Areman said he would be abstaining from the vote on this matter due to a conflict of interest. He said he supports the agreement and the Public Works staff.

Mr. Zienkowski explained that the contract is for five years and was negotiated over a 10-month period. He further explained the process through which the agreement was negotiated.

Upon motion of Mr. Norris, seconded by Mr. Zygmund-Felt, the Board of Commissioners by a 4-0-1 vote approved the Teamsters Union Local No. 115 Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) for January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2026 (Ayes: Norris, Brockington, Pransky, Zygmund-Felt. Abstention: Areman).
