



Current Bridge Projects



Ashmead Road Bridge, near Tookany Creek Parkway

Work began on January 7, 2019, and is expected to be **completed on or before November 15, 2019**. This section of Ashmead Road will be closed and detours will remain in effect until the project is complete
(Contractor, J.D.Eckman, Inc.)

Easton Road Bridge, near Toxony Avenue

Construction to replace the superstructure of this bridge began on October 1, 2018. **The anticipated completion is by early September, 2019** once milling and paving is completed. The bridge is open to traffic in both directions. (Contractor, J.P.S.Construction Co., Inc.)

Greenwood Avenue Bridge, near Hedgerow Lane

This State-owned bridge is being totally reconstructed. Work began on March 25, 2019 and will open on **October 1, 2019**. Greenwood Avenue between Church Road and Longfellow Avenue is closed to all but local traffic and the detour will remain in place for duration of the project.

Tookany Creek Parkway Bridge, near Carter Lane

This Township bridge is operating under a weight restriction of 9 tons, which prohibits school buses, trash trucks, fire trucks and other large vehicles. A bid request to install a new beam under the bridge to return the bridge to its 26-ton rating should start this fall and be complete before the end of 2019. This work will require closure of Tookany Creek Parkway for one or two days during the beam installation. Closures are planned for weekend days. Full replacement of the bridge is planned and anticipated in the next five to 10 years.

Project completion dates may change due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather.
