# SOME SENIOR FAIR EXHIBITORS MAY REQUIRE YOU TO BRING SOMETHING WITH YOU:



## SEPTA

SEPTA will be taking photos for their new SEPTA Key Senior Photo ID cards, required for seniors age 65 and older to ride free on SEPTA buses, trolleys, subways and regional rail. To apply for a SEPTA Key Senior ID at the Senior Fair, you will need a state-issued photo ID with proof of your birthdate such as a driver's license, a non-driver's ID card or passport.

## Montgomery County Recorder of Deeds

The Montgomery County Recorder of Deeds' office will be taking photos and issuing honorably discharged veterans who reside in Montgomery County their Veterans' Photo ID Discount Card, which entitles Montgomery County-based vets to receive discounts at nearly 500 establishments countywide. To receive a card, you must bring a valid photo ID, such as a driver's license or passport with proof of residency, and a copy of your discharge papers (DD Form 214).



## Pill Take Back Mobile MINI

The Montgomery County District Attorney's Pill Take Back Mobile MINI, which contains a MedReturn Box for unwanted or expired medicines, will be parked just outside the Senior Fair entrance to make it easy for you to properly dispose of unwanted and expired medications. You'll meet county detectives and be able to toss any pills you bring with you (liquids and needles are not accepted) into the car on your way into the fair.

## Flu Shots

Some vendors may be offering flu shots with proof of insurance. Be sure to bring along an insurance card or Medicare card if you plan to get vaccinated.
