

The regular meeting of the Twinning Committee was held tonight, Chair James McCann, III, presiding. Member present was Penny Geikler. Staff present was Nancy K. Gibson, Public Information Officer.

1. Upon motion of Ms. Geikler, and approved by committee, the minutes of the September 7, 2011, meeting were accepted.

2. Under **Lottery Report**, Mr. McCann reported one winner in September, which was the double draw, with a payout of \$50. He added that the application for the small games of chance license has been sent to the county. Ms. Gibson reported the lowest quote for printing the 2012 lottery tickets was \$220.90. Printing is pending the arrival of the license since the number must appear on the tickets. However, she anticipates the 2012 tickets will be available for the November meeting.

3. Under Project Reports, the following items were discussed:

A. **Twining Fingerpost Sign**: Members reviewed Ms. Gibson's proposed wording for the fingerpost sign. Mr. McCann suggested adding "Dedicated May 14, 2011." Ms. Gibson also circulated an image of a new 8" x 10" bronze sign featured in Robinson Park for the committee's consideration. Further discussion was postponed to include input from more members.

A presentation from the Township could be an item featuring the committee's twisted flags logo. Ms. Gibson urged the committee to finalize its recommendations in November to allow time for approval and production, if necessary, for the March trip.

4. Under *Old Business*, Ms. Gibson reported that Andrea White is available to staff a Twinning table at the Community Harvest Festival from noon until 3:00 p.m. Ms. Geikler will contact Ms. Spruill and Ms. Washington about their availability and advise Ms. Gibson.

5. Under *New Business*, Ms. Geikler advised that Ed Cassell from the Township's Auxiliary Police was interested in establishing a link with UK Police or Auxiliaries. Ms. Gibson should forward any UK contact information to the Auxiliary Police through Steve Labov. Mr. McCann commented that a link existed at one time between the US and UK Cheltenham Police Departments.

6. There being no further business, upon motion of Ms. Geikler, and approved by committee, the meeting was adjourned.
