1. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.
2. Upon motion of Ms. Washington, and approved by Committee, the minutes of the April 1, 2015, meeting were accepted.

5. **Old Business:** Mr. McCann reported that a Pittsburgh woman going to college in Gloucestershire UK is doing a photo project about Cheltenham UK and US, specifically
