

The regular meeting of the Twinning Committee was held tonight, Chairman James McCann, III, presiding. Members present were William Chambres, Penny Geikler, Dorothy Spruill, and Mary Washington. Staff present was Nancy K. Gibson, Public Information Officer.

1. Upon motion of Ms. Geikler, and approved by committee, the minutes of the April 3, 2013, meeting were accepted.

2. Under **2013 Lottery Report**, Mr. McCann reported three winners in April for a total payout of \$100.

3. Under Project Reports, the following items were discussed:

A. **Cheltenham UK Videos:** The Cheltenham School District video club will make copies of the Cheltenham UK history video for a \$5 donation per copy. Carrie Turner indicated that copies would be welcome at all four Township libraries. Mr. McCann obtained a vendor price of \$19 per copy. Upon motion of Ms. Spruill, and approved by Committee, copying charges up to \$40 were approved to make eight copies of the video for all Township libraries, the Richard Wall House Museum, the Old York Road Historical Society and, if accepted, Arcadia University and Cheltenham High School.

Regarding the Cheltenham UK scout video, the format is not accepted by YouTube. However, the video club may be able to convert the video for a \$5 donation. If so, it will be embedded on the Twinning page of the Township website. Upon motion of Ms. Washington, and approved by committee, an expenditure of \$5 was approved to convert the Cheltenham UK scout video to a format compatible with YouTube.

Mr. McCann reported that the damaged VHS video he received about Cheltenham UK was repaired, and he will try to view it.

B. **Twinning Archive:** Mr. McCann will provide the brief descriptions of his photos from his Cheltenham UK visit for the archives for next month. Ms. Washington will provide the archival sleeves next month as well.

C. **Exchanges:**

i. *Scouting:* Mr. McCann went to the Boy Scouts Troop 22 meeting on April 24 to show them the video made by the Cheltenham UK scouts along with photos of the UK scouts taken during his 2012 trip, but the troop was involved in other activities. He will attend the May 8 meeting to try again.

ii. *Rotary Service Clubs:* No report

iii. *Gym:* Mr. Workman requested the contact information for the UK gym, which Mr. McCann will provide.

iv. *School Students:* Ms. Washington spoke to Mrs. Putterman, a teacher at Cedarbrook, who recommended against twinning Cedarbrook students due to the large number. Mrs. Putterman suggested trying the elementary schools instead.

4. Under *Old Business*, the following item was discussed:

A. Mr. McCann circulated a sheet and asked members to provide their telephone numbers and email addresses.

5. There was no *New Business*.

6. There being no further business, upon motion of Ms. Washington, and approved by committee, the meeting was adjourned.
