
Whereas, **AILEAH GREENWOOD** first saw the fire and was rushing home to report it when she met and alerted her sister **AIYANA GREENWOOD** and friends **KHASAN BOWLEG, KHALIL LEACH** and **AARON HARRIS**. **AARON HARRIS** called 911, while **KHASAN BOWLEG** and **KHALIL LEACH** banged on the property's door and awakened the resident who had been unaware of the fire; and

Whereas, The arriving fire company found a significant fire that was just entering the structure's inside spaces and was fortunately able to limit the damage to the back of the house. Because building fires can double in size every minute, the alert actions of these four youths undoubtedly saved the house from more extensive damage and potentially saved a life that was in genuine peril.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, duly convened in regular session this Sixteenth Day of August, A.D., 2017, does hereby officially honor and thank **AILEAH GREENWOOD, AIYANA GREENWOOD, KHASAN BOWLEG, KHALIL LEACH** and **AARON HARRIS** for their fast thinking and decisive action in the face of a dangerous situation. It is further directed that this Resolution be spread in full upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy thereof be conveyed to each one of them.
