
Whereas, **ROBERT SCHOLLY SR.**, joined the Glenside Fire Company on March 29, 1957. Over the next 60 years he served the company as Lieutenant for a year, Captain for nine years, Deputy Chief for four years and Chief for eight years, and earned several awards for life-saving rescues. But even more impressively, in every one of those 60 years, **ROBERT SCHOLLY SR.**, was an active member charging into burning structures, often with other firefighters half his age, to protect the lives, property and welfare of his neighbors and community; and


Whereas, A former Cheltenham Police Detective, **ROBERT SCHOLLY SR.**, embodies the highest qualities of self-less service. Although he retired from the Active Crew in March 2017, he will remain an inspirational role model who is respected, admired and beloved by his fellow firefighters, including his son and grandson who are continuing the Scholly dynasty with the Glenside Fire Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, duly convened in regular session this Nineteenth Day of April, A.D., 2017, does hereby officially honor **ROBERT SCHOLLY SR.**, for his 60 years of outstanding, distinguished service to the community and applauds his continuing contributions to the Glenside Fire Company.
