**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING TOWNSHIP
ADMINISTRATION TO PURSUE GRANT UNDER THE
2017 NATIONAL FISH & WILDLIFE FOUNDATION
DELAWARE RIVER RESTORATION PROGRAM TO
DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT THE DRIVE EXTENSION,
PERVIOUS PAVER PARKING AND STORMWATER
MANAGEMENT SYSTEM PROPOSED FOR THE EVENT
SPACE IN THE CURTIS ARBORETUM CONSERVATION
AND LANDSCAPE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Township of Cheltenham, Montgomery County, desires to increase parking in Curtis Arboretum serving Curtis Hall in order to increase the usability of Curtis Hall for events, protect the valuable arboretum plants and improve infiltration and water quality on the site; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township completed a Conservation and Landscape Management Plan for the Curtis Arboretum which identifies expanding the parking area nearest Curtis Hall as an important aspect to preserving the planned and natural landscape of the Arboretum and increasing its economic viability; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township desires to apply to the National Fish & Wildlife Foundation Delaware River Restoration Program for a grant for the purpose of carrying out this project; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township has received and understands the 2017 National Fish & Wildlife Foundation Delaware River Restoration Program Guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, hereby approves this project and authorizes the submission of an application to the National Fish & Wildlife Foundation Delaware River Restoration Program in the amount of \$100,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if the application is granted, the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, hereby authorizes the Township Manager or his designee to execute all contracts, agreements, or other documents required to implement and carry out the grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if the application is granted, the Township of Cheltenham commits to the expenditure of matching funds in the amount of \$271,485 necessary for the project's success (Budget attached).
