RESOLUTION NO. 09-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO SIGN AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL APPROVAL AT THE FOLLOWING INTERSECTIONS: (1) GREENWOOD AVENUE, LONGFELLOW AVENUE, AND RICES MILL ROAD; (2) SHOPPERS LANE AND OGONTZ AVENUE; (3) ASHBOURNE ROAD AND NEW SECOND STREET; (4) LIMEKILN PIKE AND CHURCH ROAD⁽²⁾; (5) LIMEKILN PIKE AND EASTON ROAD⁽²⁾; EASTON ROAD AND ROUTE 309 NB AND SB RAMPS; (6) LIMEKILN PIKE AND HARRISON AVENUE; (7) LIMEKILIN PIKE AND WAVERLY ROAD; AND (8) LIMELKIN PIKE AND GLENSIDE AVENUE TO CARRY OUT THE IMPROVEMENTS FUNDED BY ROUND 2 OF THE GREEN LIGHT—GO GRANT PROGRAM (2015 APPLICATION)

WHEREAS, the Township of Cheltenham, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania received grant funding through the PennDOT Green Light—Go grant program to pursue five projects including:

1. Greenwood Avenue, Longfellow Road and Rices Mill Road Intersection Improvements
2. Shoppers Lane and Ogontz Avenue Intersection Study and Safety Improvements
3. Pedestrian Accessibility Improvements Two Intersections at Arcadia University
4. GPS Time Clock Upgrades at Six Intersections along Intersections of Easton Road and Limekiln Pike
5. Ashbourne Road and New Second Street Traffic Signal Repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that improvements to these intersections will help improve the safety and efficiency of their operation; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation requires submission of an Application for Traffic Signal Approval prior to installation or modification of any traffic signal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the authority of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cheltenham, Montgomery County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the Township Manager of Cheltenham Township is authorized and directed to

submit the attached Application for Traffic Signal Approval to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and to sign this Application on behalf of Cheltenham Township.


