**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE
TOWNSHIP ADMINISTRATION TO SUBMIT A GRANT
APPLICATION AND EXECUTE ON THE TOWNSHIP'S
BEHALF ANY CONTRACTS, AGREEMENTS, OR OTHER
DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN AND/OR
ADMINISTER A GRANT UNDER THE MONTGOMERY
COUNTY MONTCO 2040 IMPLEMENTATION GRANT
PROGRAM TO SUPPORT THE DESIGN AND
INSTALLATION OF WAYFINDING SIGNAGE AND
PUBLIC ART IN THE ELKINS PARK EAST AND WEST
COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Cheltenham, Montgomery County, desires to apply for funding from Montgomery County under its MontCo 2040 Implementation Grant Program to financially aid in the implementation of Township's Commercial District Enhancement Program in the Elkins Park East and West Commercial Districts; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township completed Commercial District Enhancement Plans for the Elkins Park East and West Commercial Districts in 2000, which outlines a vision and implementation plan for economic development, transportation improvements and streetscape enhancements; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township has received funding under the Transportation Alternatives Program and Multimodal Transportation Fund grant programs and has begun to implement the recommendations of the Commercial District Enhancement Plans in Elkins Park West; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township has recently applied for a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant to begin implementing the recommendations of the Commercial District Enhancement Plans in Elkins Park East; and

WHEREAS, Cheltenham Township's Commercial District Enhancement Program furthers Montgomery County's focus on supporting Downtowns and Community Destinations; and

WHEREAS, the wayfinding signage and public art proposed for the Elkins Park East and West Commercial Districts will address Montgomery County's goals of Connected Communities and a Vibrant Economy by helping connect motorists and pedestrians with the many businesses, transportation hubs and cultural attractions in the Elkins Park Commercial Districts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, desires to file a MontCo 2040 Implementation Grant application to secure funds in an amount up to \$100,000 based on the total project cost of \$145,000 per the attached Cost Estimates (Exhibit A) for the purpose of designing and installing public art in the Elkins Park West Commercial District and wayfinding signage directing motorists from Old York Road (S.R. 611) to businesses, transportation hubs, and cultural assets in the Elkins Park Commercial Districts, which will coordinate with streetscape improvement efforts already underway and are part of the Cheltenham Township Commercial District Enhancement Plan and Comprehensive Plan of Cheltenham Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township, Montgomery County does hereby authorize the Township Manager/Secretary and his/her designee to execute all documents, contracts, and agreements between Cheltenham Township and Montgomery County to facilitate and assist in obtaining and administering the requested grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township of Cheltenham will commit to a match of \$45,000 as its local share of the project costs.


